IMPORTANT

- Call the CMA line (303-470-5856) and alert us if your child is going to miss class, so that their absence may be excused. Students with more than two *un-excused* absences may be asked to step out of the concert.

- You have until May 3rd (The night of the performance) to pay your total tuition. We are flexible with payment plans and you will not be billed during this session. However, if we do not receive your full amount by May 3rd, you will be billed & charged a \$10 late fee.

- If you have an emergency and need to reach a student or teacher during class time, please call Tiffany Case at (303-916-6979). Do not use the church office for calls.

Class Dress Code

- * Black leggings (comfortable fit exercise pants). No jeans or shorts.
- * A loose fitting t-shirt that covers the stomach when hands are raised. The shirt must have no inappropriate or offensive writing. Because of the movements in class, girls must have higher necked (no V or boat necked) shirts, so they are covered as they stretch & move.
- * Pink leather ballet shoes, with elastic strap (white leather shoes for boys) are required.
- * Girl's hair should be pulled up off the face & secured to the head in a clip or bun.

Students 3-5yr old may wear leotards with tights if desired (not mandatory).

Costume

Patterns are available at the front table Required for the concert, all dancers need:

- * White Skirt (Boys white, loose fitting pants)
 - WD 1-2 need satin drop-waist skirt
 - WD 3 & up need circle skirt & bloomers
- * A plain white top (t-shirt or blouse) loose fitting, short sleeved, no writing or sparkles
- * WD 4 & up need a long sleeve white leotard to wear under their white shirt
- * Gold lamé belt & gold lamé scrunchie
- * Girls-Pink tights / Boys-thin white socks
- * Girls-pink leather ballet shoes -*With elastic strap*
 - Boys-white leather ballet shoes
- * Girl's hair must be pulled back into a bun

~ Rules Form ~

Please read the following slowly and completely

This is a list of rules that have been compiled from church requests and problems that have arisen over the past few years. Please take time to read each rule completely and talk them over with your child. CMA has been incredibly blessed by churches who have opened their doors to us and supported this ministry. Please do your best to comply with the rules, and help us honor these wonderful churches!



1. Keep hallways and foyers as clear and quiet as possible. (South Fellowship's staff is working)
2. If you need to wait for your child during class time, please wait quietly in the room designated for parents, Room 106. There should be no children running or playing in the halls. *South Fellowship's "Solid Grounds" coffee shop is at the end of the strip mall is a great place to wait during class time. It is also a great way to help support South Fellowship's ministry.*
3. No playing in the playground area, this is for the Early Learning Center only.
4. Children should be **supervised at all times**. You may bring quiet games or school work for your children, however be sure that the toys stay near your seating area.
5. No parking/waiting in front of South Fellowship or the Early Learning Center (the area with the white fence)
6. Only go/wait inside rooms that have been approved by CMA staff. (Only certain rooms are rented)
7. In between class time (when you pick up or drop off your student) please help us keep the halls and foyer as calm and quiet as possible.
8. No writing on chalk boards or dry erase boards in the church facility.
9. No touching musical instruments in the class rooms.
10. Clean up your area when you leave. (Food, wrappers, toys, etc.)
11. Please put furniture (tables and chairs) back how you found it.
12. Children should **only be outside with adult supervision.**
13. **No playing or hanging in trees on church property.**
14. On "Observation Day" please remember: NO cell phones. NO talking. Please keep siblings quiet or kindly take them out of the room, & please limit the amount of times entering and exiting the class room. These things will help the teacher and the students run a focused and productive class. Thank you for your cooperation.
15. Please read over our dress code rules on the 1st week note (attached to the front of this page).
16. CLASS ATTENDANCE is very important. Because we only have 12 weeks to prepare the children for the performance day, each class is vital. When a student is missing the other children get confused about formations within the dance, especially if the missing student was their partner. This is hard on the teacher as well because she has to spend time the following week catching the missing student up on the choreography they missed. We know some things are unavoidable and children get sick. However we do ask that you try to make attendance a high priority.
